Please be at finish line at start of 2nd run with racer envelopes.

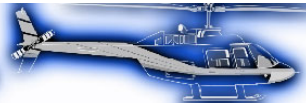
One final reminder, **PLEASE make a final run to be sure clean-up is done!!!**
